BY-LAW NO. 5344-21

A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF PARTY BICYCLES WITHIN THE TOWN BOUNDARIES OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NIAGARA-ON-THE-LAKE

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001 Section 11(2) provides that a municipality may pass by-laws for the protection of persons and property;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, Section 11(3) provides that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters for transportation systems, other than highways;

AND WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of The Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake passed a motion at the July 20, 2020, meeting addressing concerns with safety, traffic congestion, and proximity of proposed routes to residential areas with Party Bicycles;

AND WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of The Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake adopted the recommendations contained in CS-20-020 on August 24, 2020;

AND WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of The Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake has deemed that it does not desire the operation of Party Bicycles within the Municipal Boundaries of the Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NIAGARA-ON-THE-LAKE enacts as follows:

- 1. DEFINITIONS:
 - 1(a) Party Bicycle means a pedal-powered vehicle that is designed for operation on roadways, having seating for four (4) or more people.
- 2. that a Party Bicycle is not permitted to operate within the Municipal Boundaries of the Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake.
- 3. this By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof.
