BY-LAW NO. 5156A-19**

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 5156-19 BEING A BY-LAW FOR THE MANAGEMENT, REGULATION & CONTROL OF NIAGARA LAKE SHORE CEMETERY.

**WHEREAS** The Corporation of the Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake approved By-law 5156-19 on January 14, 2019 pursuant to Section 150 of Ontario Regulation 30/11 of the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002;

**AND WHEREAS** it is necessary to update the rules and regulations for the Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake to be compliant with the Act and direction of the Bereavement Authority of Ontario.

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NIAGARA-ON-THE-LAKE** enacts as follows:

1. That By-law 5156 being a by-law for the management, regulation and control of Niagara Lake Shore Cemetery be amended by replacing the word “and” and replacing it with the word “or” under the definition of section 1.3 Care and Maintenance Fund, to read as follows:  
  
“1.3 **Care and Maintenance Fund** means the trust fund in which a percentage of the purchase price of all Interment Rights *or* set amounts for marker and monument installations is contributed; and wherein the interest earned from such funds is used to provide care and maintenance of lots, plots, markers and structures in the cemetery.
2. That By-law 5156 being a by-law for the management, regulation and control of Niagara Lake Shore Cemetery be amended by adding “IV. A consumer information guide” to the list provided under section 3.9 of the by-law to read as follows:  
“3.9 All purchasers of Interment Rights shall be provided with the following:
  - I. A copy of the contract
  - II. A copy of the Niagara Lake Shore Cemetery By-law
  - III. A Certificate of Interment Rights
  - IV. A consumer information guide
3. That By-law 5156 being a by-law for the management, regulation and control of Niagara Lake Shore Cemetery be amended by adding” with

the exception of service animals” to the end of Section 7.10 to read as follows:

- “7.10 No dogs shall be allowed in the Cemetery, with the exception of service animals.”
5. That the Lord Mayor and Clerk be authorized to affix their hands and the Corporate Seal; and
  6. THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND PASSED THIS 16<sup>th</sup> DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2019.
